Dear Parents,

Our goal is to keep OLPH as safe as possible for children with food allergies. All OLPH students eat in Harrison Hall. To assist students with peanut and nut allergies, we have designated a specific table where peanuts and nut products will not be permitted (the “peanut/nut free allergy table”). Children who do not have peanut and nut allergies are also permitted to sit at this table with written agreement from their parents not to send in any food products containing peanuts or nuts for the entire school year. To help protect our students with allergies, students are NOT permitted to go back and forth between the peanut/nut-free allergy table and non-restricted tables.

Please review the options below. Only parents whose children have severe peanut or nut allergies or otherwise wish to sit at the peanut or nut-free allergy table need sign and return this form. Children for whom the school has not received a signed form will be assigned to a non-restricted table where peanut and nut products are permitted.
