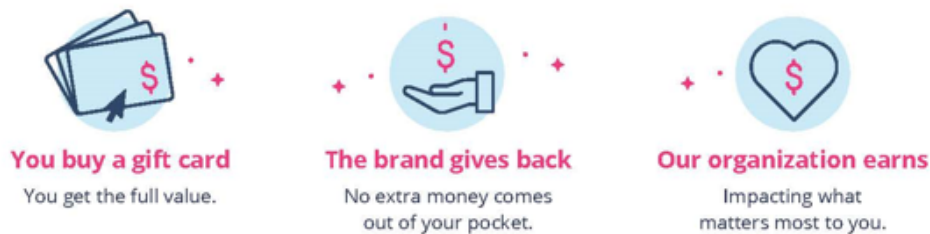


## 2022-23 Scrip Program Information

Our gift certificate/Scrip program has been in place for many years, and serves as one of our major fundraisers for the school. We partner with ShopwithScrip.com, an online ordering system which keeps our program in conformity with Archdiocesan guidelines, to allow us to offer gift cards from hundreds of different merchants. The program is managed by our scrip coordinators, Mr. & Mrs. Jeff Taegel.



### Program framework:

- All school families are required to participate in the program.
- Program period is June 1, 2022 – May 15, 2023
- The Opt-Out fee is \$150
- Total required purchase amount for each participating family is **\$2,500**
- Plastic and e-gift cards are available (the RaiseRight app makes participation very easy)
- If, by May 15, 2023, you have not purchased \$2,500 in scrip, you will be assessed 5% of the difference between \$2,500 and your purchase amount, payable by June 1, 2023.

- Please designate your youngest student's name and homeroom teacher as part of your family profile. Returning families, please update your youngest child's homeroom teacher.
- Presto Pay is the preferred payment option. If paying by check, gift cards will not be released for shipment to the school until your check has been received at the school.

During the school year, the coordinator processes orders for plastic gift cards once a week, with the order deadline **each Sunday night**. In the summer, it is twice a month in June and August. During the school year, plastic gift cards are distributed by Friday afternoon. Electronic gift cards may be purchased at any time.
